

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE TOWN OF DUCK, NORTH CAROLINA BY INCREASING
THE ALLOWABLE DEPTH OF WALL-MOUNTED SIGNS**

Ordinance No. 17-01

WHEREAS, the Duck Town Council and Planning Board have determined that increasing the allowable depth of wall-mounted signs is necessary to allow standard construction and installation practices for internally lighted wall signs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that increasing the allowable depth of wall-mounted signs lessens the expense and provides greater flexibility with signs for local business owners; and

WHEREAS, the Duck Town Council and Planning Board have found that amending the allowable depth of wall-mounted signs is in the public interest and consistent with the recommendations of the Town's adopted CAMA Core Land Use Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council for the Town of Duck, North Carolina that the Zoning Ordinance shall be amended as follows:

PART I. Amend Subsection 156.130(C)(1)(f) of the Duck Town Code by increasing the allowable depth of wall-mounted signs from six inches (6") to twelve inches (12").

Specifically, the amended Subsection 156.130(C)(1)(f) of the Duck Town Code will read as follows:


"(f) Wall signs shall not extend more than twelve inches (12") in depth from the building face to which they are attached."

PART II. This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption.
