

BEACH PROTECTION

Expenditures in the Beach Protection category are related to the planning and construction of the Town’s Beach Nourishment Project and the planting and fertilization annually of beach grass and sea oats, as well as the monitoring of the beach profile. The category also includes debt service on the Special Obligation Bonds (SOBs) issued by the Town for the project.

The FY 2019 Budget for Beach Protection is expected to decrease by 2% from the FY 2018 Amended Budget. This is due to a slight decrease in the Repairs and Maintenance and Debt Service line items.

Below is a chart that shows the Beach Protection budget from FY 2014 to the FY 2019 Budget with an additional forecast to FY 2024.
